Mandy Mikita Scott is in her 21st year of teaching, and her sixteenth at her alma mater, Rockford High School (Rockford, Michigan), where she is Director of Choirs and teaches around 125 students daily in four ensembles. She feels privileged to be on a team with her husband, Jed Scott, who directs the Rockford Aces and volunteers much of his time to support the choir program.

Mandy studied at Western Michigan University with Joe Miller and Steve Zegree and received her Master of Music in Choral Conducting from the University of Miami with Jo-Michael Scheibe. She is grateful that her choirs have had the opportunity to perform in Carnegie Hall, the National Cathedral, the World Choir Games in Riga, Latvia (where they earned Gold Medals in their categories) and St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, Italy. Most recently, in 2023 she conducted a concert tour of Spain with the Rockford Choirs with sold-out concerts in Barcelona, Valencia, and Madrid.

Her choirs have also performed at both the ACDA-Michigan Fall Conference and the Michigan Music Conference. She has conducted an ensemble at the MSVMA All-State Ensemble Recital eight times.

The Rockford Choirs actively commission new choral works, and under her direction, the choirs have commissioned over 30 compositions and arrangements, including works from Z. Randall Stroope, Alice Parker, Andrea Ramsey, Michael McGlynn, Anders Edenroth, and many others.

Mandy was the Michigan High School SSAA State Honors Choir conductor in 2014, and has served terms on both as High School Repertoire chair and the Board of Directors as the Director of Sight Reading and Music Selection. She has also served on the ACDA-Michigan Board.

Mandy was recognized as Eric Whitacre Teacher of the Week in December, 2019. She is humbled to have four times been named as a finalist for MSVMA Teacher of the Year. She is proudest that her former students continue to make music and breathe kindness into the world.

Most of all, Mandy has had fabulous choral opportunities in her career thanks to her incredible husband and family. Together, they have spent time with legendary choral composer Alice Parker on her farm in Massachusetts, hosted The Real Group in Rockford, and written poetry with her youngest, Daniella, for an Andrea Ramsey composition. Mandy and Jed have three children, Owen, Julian, and Daniella (who were all singing in MSVMA Honors Choirs this year at MMC!)

Dr. Joe Miller

All-State Festival Honors Choir Conductor

Recognized as a visionary conductor and creative artist, Joe Miller maintains an active performance schedule. Miller currently serves as Professor of Conducting and Director of Choral Studies at CCM. In addition to his work at CCM, Miller is artistic director of choral activities for the renowned Spoleto Festival USA in Charleston, South Carolina, and since 2016 he has served as conductor of the Philadelphia Orchestra Symphonic Choir.

Miller made his conducting debut with the Philadelphia Orchestra in 2021, conducting Handel's *Messiah*. Recent collaborations with Yannick Nézet-Séguin and the Philadelphia Orchestra have included premier performances of Kevin Puts' *The Hours* with Renée Fleming, Kelli O'Hara and Jennifer Johnson Cano, along with premier performances in Carnegie Hall of Gabriela Franks' *Pachamama Meets and Ode*. Past seasons' engagements have also included Beethoven's *Ninth Symphony* with the Spoleto Festival USA Orchestra and Chorus and Poulenc's *Stabat Mater* with the CCM Choirs and Philharmonia.

Featured works of the 2022-23 CCM season include performances for the ACDA National Conference, Joby Talbot's *Path of Miracles*, and a collaboration with the Cincinnati Ballet featuring the CCM Chamber Choir and choreographer Taylor Carrasco. The Philadelphia Orchestra season includes Rachmaninov *Kolokol/The Bells* being recorded for Deutsche Gramophone, Handel's *Messiah*, and the Bruckner *Te Deum*.

After viewing a staged performance of Joby Talbot's demanding *Path of Miracles* at the 2019 Spoleto Festival USA, D.C. Theatre Scene wrote, "Joe Miller is a fearless artist. His bold leadership and trust in these young singers enabled his choristers to forego the 'stand and deliver,' score-bound habits of their genre and 'walk with him' on this special journey. Not only did the singers need to memorize their parts, no mean feat, but follow his baton's bid from any part of the auditorium and sing in any body position. Miller constantly challenged them in the process and inspired them to work confidently, well outside their comfort zone."

Miller's ensembles have performed throughout the world, giving concert tours in Italy, Germany, Austria, France, England, China and Spain, as well as participating in the World Symposium on Choral Music in Barcelona. His choirs have toured extensively throughout the US performing for the American Choral Director's Association National and Regional Conferences, and including groundbreaking performances of Julia Wolfe's Pulitzer Prize-winning *Anthracite Fields* at the historic Roebing WireWorks as part of Westminster's Transforming Space project.

Miller has been praised for his recordings. American Record Guide's review of Frank Martin: *Mass for Double Choir* stated: "This is gorgeous singing ... with perfect blend, intonation, diction, ensemble and musicality." The Heart's Reflection: Music of Daniel Elder was hailed by Minnesota Public Radio's Classical Notes as "simply astounding." Miller's debut recording with the Westminster Choir, *Flower of Beauty*, received four stars from *Choir & Organ* magazine and earned critical praise from American Record Guide, which described the Westminster Choir as "the gold standard for academic choirs in America."

Miller has collaborated with some of the world's leading orchestras and conductors, earning him critical praise.

Todd Schreiber, originally from Ohio City, OH, resides in Lambertville, MI. He holds a bachelor's degree in music education from Bowling Green State University and a master's degree from VanderCook College in Chicago and is currently in his 34th year as K-12 vocal music instructor and theatre director for Whiteford Schools in Ottawa Lake, MI.

Todd has served the Michigan School Vocal Music Association as District 12 Co-Manager for the past 20 years and has often been an accompanist for workshops, conferences and honors choirs in the state. His choirs, ensembles and private voice students consistently participate in MSVMA district and state level events, including the Michigan Youth Arts Festival.

Mr. Schreiber is also a member of the Canterbury Singers USA with which he has sung several choral residencies at cathedrals in England. His book, *Olympic Games for the Music Classroom*, was published in 2008 by Shawnee Press. In 2010, Todd directed the 7-8-9 SSA State Honors Choir and in 2017 conducted the 7-8-9 TTB State Honors Choir. He was extremely honored to be named the MSVMA Teacher of the Year in 2013 and in 2015 he earned The Outstanding Alumni Award from his high school alma mater.
