I would have come to the All-State in 2020 as I had the same student gain acceptance that spring. But unfortunately we know the history of that entire year.




So far, the experience has been great. My student and I love the selected music. She is very excited about the chance to finally be a part of this choir."

Calling all MMC Interest Session Presenters and MMC Choral Hour Applicants! Both deadlines are quickly approaching so I wanted to offer an explanation to anyone who is new to the process.

Interest Session Presenters: The deadline for session proposals is April 28, 2023. After following the link below, you'll create an account and register. You don't need to have all of the details figured out for your session, but you should have a title, description, demonstration choir and/or piano needs, and basic room needs. After the deadline, the MMC Planning Committee will review submissions for approval and scheduling. However, we can only approve and schedule what is submitted! If you've ever thought, "Why don't we have a session about \_\_\_\_\_\_ this year", it's possibly because it wasn't submitted! EVERYONE is encouraged to apply.

2024 MMC Interest Submissions

Choral Hour Applicants: The deadline for Choral Hour applicants is May 15, 2023. Using the link below, you'll complete a Google Form detailing your ensemble information and submit three recordings, two of which must be from this current school year. One must be acapella. From there, the recordings move to a blind listening panel for selection. Our goal is to have all schools notified during the month of June so you can make arrangements for next year as necessary. Similarly to what you read above, the blind listening panel can only choose from submitted recordings! If you've ever left a Choral Hour performance thinking, "Maybe I'll try next year", this is your chance!

# Rackham Choir High School Vocal Internship Program Auditions September 2023 - May 2024 Season

Saturday, June 17, 2023 @, First Presbyterian Church of Royal Oak

The Rackham Choir High School Vocal Internship Program is pleased to announce auditions for its upcoming 2023-2024 Season. The program is designed to support students with exceptional vocal talent and commitment who are entering their sophomore, junior, or senior year of high school in Fall 2023 and who aspire to study music, musical theater, or music education in college. Please pass along this information to students who could benefit from this program!

Selected Rackham Choir High School Vocal Interns will:

- Receive a scholarship toward private vocal instruction with a private instructor.
- Enjoy full membership in Rackham Choir with dues waived for the 2023-2024 season (rehearsals typically Tuesdays 7 PM-9 PM.
- Rehearse and perform under the baton of Maestro Brandon Waddles, Rackham's Artistic and Music Director and Assistant Professor of Choral Conducting & Music Education at Wayne State University.
- Receive coaching with Maestro Waddles and collaborative pianist and instructor Julian Goods in preparation for college or conservatory auditions.
- Master class performances with Rackham Choir artists serving as clinicians.
- Be a featured soloist in a spring concert showcasing the Rackham Choir High School Vocal Interns.
- Receive mentoring by adult members of the Rackham Choir.

To be considered for an audition, the student must:

- Be in good academic standing.
- Submit the enclosed application and letter of recommendation (submitted by author) prior to June 3, 2023 to administration@rackhamchoir.org.
- Submit video recording(s) of two (2) contrasting musical selections any genre of classical
  or musical theater music appropriate for young voices is acceptable. Selections must be
  memorized. Video recordings should be uploaded to this link:

Finalists will be invited to the live final auditions at First Presbyterian Church of Royal Oak; 529 Hendrie Blvd, Royal Oak, MI 48067 on Saturday, June 17, 2023. Alternate live audition times can be arranged in June if necessary. Singers who are awarded the Rackham Choir High School Vocal Internship will be required to maintain good academic standing, attend Rackham rehearsals, and attend voice lessons.
